# Introduction

KDI has produced this document to make disaggregated data of the final list of candidates released by the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) available to stakeholders. KDI has drawn patterns and trends on how political parties in Nigeria fielded candidates for the presidential/NASS election coming up on the 25th of February 2023 and Governorship and State Houses of Assembly coming up on the 11th of March 2023 in 28 States. Secondly, these analyses aim to enhance credible voter education so that we can have a well-informed electorate ahead of the election.


While all the political parties have fielded candidates for the presidential election, the real strength of each political party was majorly demonstrated in the subnational elections. This analysis shows that there are 4 parties with national coverage: the ADC, APC, NNPP, and PDP. This submission is based on the representation rate of these parties across all the elections.




### Gender Distribution of Governorship and Deputy Governorship Candidates per State










### Gender Distribution of Senatorial Candidates per Geo-political Zone











#### Gender Distribution of HoR Candidates per Geo-political Zone




#### **Gender Distribution of SHoA Candidates per State**








